- 3. Financial Capacity: Audited financial statements for the last 2 years
- 4. **Experience:** Minimum 2 years experience in relevant category
- 5. **Insurance:** Valid professional indemnity and public liability insurance

Technical Requirements:

- 1. Quality Standards: Demonstrated ability to meet international quality standards
- 2. **Delivery Capability:** Proven track record of timely delivery
- 3. After-sales Support: Availability of maintenance and support services
- 4. **References:** Minimum 3 verifiable client references

Preferred Qualifications:

- 1. Local Presence: Suppliers within 50km of TRIDI offices (Kalagi, Mukono)
- 2. Long-term Partnership: Demonstrated commitment to sustainable partnerships
- 3. Innovation: Use of modern technology and innovative solutions
- 4. Social Impact: Contribution to local community development
- 5. Environmental Compliance: Adherence to environmental protection standards

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 2. Company Profile including organizational structure and capabilities
- 3. Certificate of Incorporation and business registration documents
- 4. Tax Clearance Certificate (current)
- 5. Audited Financial Statements (2022 and 2023)
- 6. Client References (minimum 3 with contact details)
- 7. Insurance Certificates (professional indemnity and public liability)
- 8. Sample Work Portfolio (where applicable)
- 9. Price Lists or indicative pricing for standard items
- 10. Compliance Certificates (ISO, quality standards where applicable)

Application Format:

- Applications must be submitted in both hard copy and electronic format
- All documents must be properly signed and stamped
- Incomplete applications will be automatically disqualified
- Late submissions will not be considered

EVALUATION PROCESS

Phase 1: Preliminary Screening (September 1-10, 2025)

- Document completeness verification
- Basic eligibility criteria assessment
- Compliance requirements check

Phase 2: Technical Evaluation (September 11-20, 2025)

- Technical competence assessment
- Financial capacity analysis
- Reference verification
- Site visits (where necessary)

Phase 3: Final Selection (September 21, 2025 - October 5, 2025)

- Comprehensive scoring and ranking
- Committee deliberations
- Final approval and notification

Evaluation Criteria Weighting:

- Technical Competence: 30%
- Financial Capacity: 25%
- Past Performance: 20%
- Compliance: 15%
- Cost Competitiveness: 10%

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i. No Guarantee: This invitation does not guarantee any future contracts or purchase orders. Pre-qualification only establishes eligibility for future bidding opportunities.
- ii. Validity Period: Pre-qualification status shall be valid for 24 months from the date of approval, subject to annual performance reviews.
- iii. Performance Standards: Pre-qualified suppliers must maintain performance standards throughout the validity period. Poor performance may lead to suspension or removal from the list.
- iv. Framework Agreements: Selected suppliers may be invited to enter into framework agreements specifying terms and conditions for future procurements.
- v. Compliance Requirements: All suppliers must comply with TRIDI's procurement policies, donor requirements, and applicable laws and regulations.
- vi. Confidentiality: All information submitted will be treated with strict confidentiality and used solely for evaluation purposes.

The process involves three phases: Preliminary Screening (Sept 15th –19th), Technical Evaluation (Sept 22–30), and Final Selection (Oct 1st – Oct 10th). Evaluation is based on technical competence (30%), financial capacity (25%), past performance (20%), compliance (15%), and cost (10%).

- ii. Canvassing or lobbying will lead to automatic disqualification
- iii. False information in applications will result in permanent blacklisting
